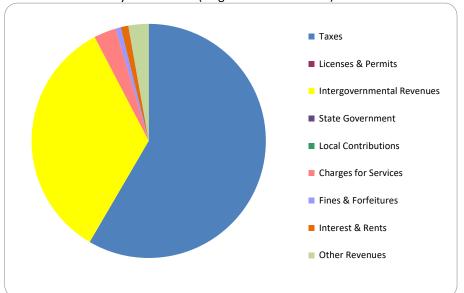

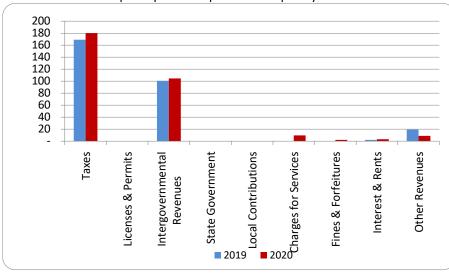

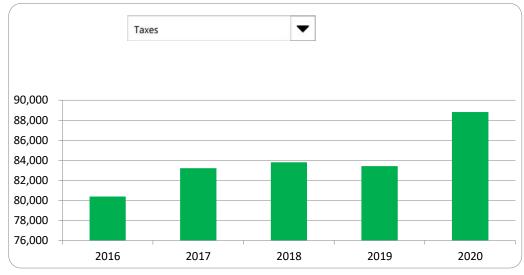

3. Revenue sources per capita - compared to the prior year

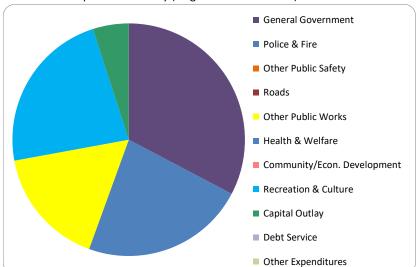


4. Historical trends of individual sources

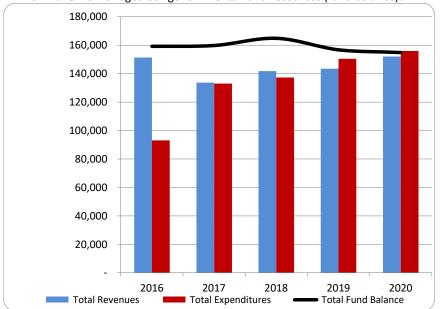

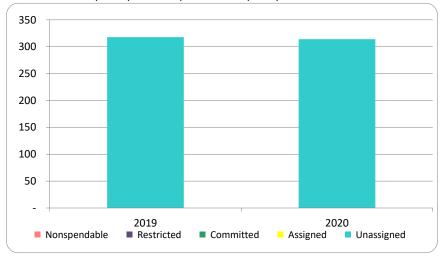

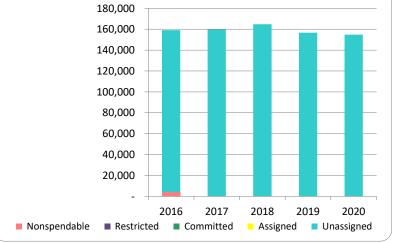

3. Fund balance per capita - compared to the prior year



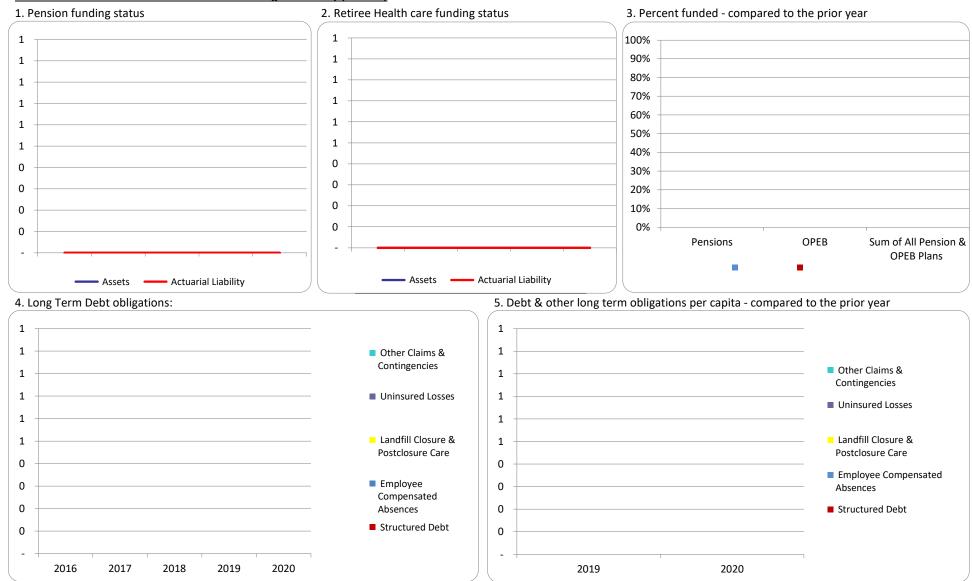
